Notes: Worked a year as hon medical officer of Cowra district hospital, NSW, covering for his uncle: "Dr. [F. P.] Bartlett's brother with his wife and two sons, Drs Ralph and Frank, came to Cowra on a visit in 1892, and their doing so enabled Dr. F.P. Bartlett to pay another visit to England, his practice being entrusted to his two nephews, who soon adapted themselves to Australian conditions, and became exceedingly popular during their 12 months adjourn. Dr. F.P. Bartlett resumed his practice in 1893, and his visiting relatives returned to England" ("Cowra in days gone bye", J C Ryall, 1990).
